- Primary care clinic in East London for people with difficulty accessing mainstream NHS
- Staffed by volunteer GPs, nurses & support workers
- Advocacy service for GP registration and secondary care
- Influencing health policy and practice

#### **NHS England Guidance on Registration**



#### **Key points**

- Anyone in England can register and consult with a GP without charge
- Nationality and immigration status are not relevant to GP registration
- ✓ There is no requirement for proof of ID or address to register
- Patients without a fixed address can register using the practice address
- On suspicion of fraud, patients should be registered and treated and the matter handed over to the NHS Counter Fraud Authority
- ✓ If there is uncertainty on the length of time a patient is in the area e.g. asylum seekers in Home Office accommodation -> permanent patient registration




#### What is a Safe Surgery?

- A Safe Surgery is any GP practice which commits to taking steps to tackle the barriers to healthcare faced by underserved communities
- Small changes in practice to ensure that lack of ID or proof of address, immigration status or language are not barriers to patient registration
- Practices signed up receive free training, resources and support to align with NHS England guidance on GP registration



#### % 7 Steps for Safe Patient Registration



- Don't insist on proof of address
- 2. Don't insist on ID
- 3. Never ask about immigration status
- 4. Keep information safe
- 5. Use an interpreter
- 6. Display Posters
- 7. Empower frontline staff
